Below are descriptions of all the plants we are offering this year.

GERANIUMS

The most full and beautiful **geraniums** you will ever buy!

- Choose from fuchsia, red, pink, salmon and white.
- Nursery grown in 4-inch pots.
- Purchase by the pot or in flats.
- Mix any color combination you desire.

This year we are also offering **ivy geraniums**, as well!

- Chose from rose, red, pink, burgundy, lavender and blush.

HANGING BASKETS

If you have seen these in the past, you know they are gorgeous! Choose from the following:

- The **lantana** is always a big hit. It has beautiful red or yellow flowers and attracts butterflies. It is drought tolerant, very adaptable and has outstanding heat tolerance.
- The **yellow begonia** has large double flowers and is sensational. It likes sun to partial shade and is rabbit and squirrel resistant. Like the lantana, it also attracts butterflies.
- The **pink ivy geranium** flowers like mad and requires little maintenance.
- The **rose double impatiens** have beautiful rose-like blooms and like shade.
- The **mixed calibrachoa** has flowers that are like mini petunias. It comes in a combination of blue, pink and yellow blooms and loves sun.
- The **purple wave petunias** are spectacular!
- The **Boston fern** is *amazing!* These plants are huge and hearty!

POTS

We are offering the following for all of your gardening needs:

- **Sweet potato vine** its unique shaped leaves, in purple or yellow, will provide color and interest in your pot or garden.
- **Purple fountain grass** is a fast-growing clump grass with purple foliage and foxtail-like flowers.
- **Vinca vine** is a trailing vine that grows green and white leaves and blooms with delicate violet trumpet-like flowers.
- We have added **foliage spikes** and **variegated English ivy** this year!

FLATS

We have all the flowers you need for your gardens this year!

- **Gazania:** These have beautiful showy flowers and are highly drought tolerant. Trailing foliage with upright flowers do best in sun and keep blooming from May to the first frost! The flowers close at night and open with sunlight to display their extravagant array of colors. Ideal for garden fillers and containers.
- **Snapdragon:** Plant these 10-12" short mixed flowers in your full sun areas. They have fantastic blooms and continue blooming with deadheading. These are one of nature's most stunning examples of color and beauty.
- **Coleus:** Plant these mixed plants in sun to shade. Coleus is prized for its brilliant and widely varied colorful foliage.
- **Pansy:** These flowers are popular, fun and easy to grow. They grow well in partially sunny areas such as morning sun. Pansies are perfect in gardens, window boxes and containers. Always a favorite.
- **Lobelia:** These beautiful blue trailing flowers are perfect for flower boxes and containers. It is an outstanding plant for all summer flowering performance and is bred for heat tolerance. Plant in full sun to partial shade.
- **Impatiens:** Wondering what to plant in those shady areas? We have just the answer—impatiens! We are offering: white, red, pink, purple and hot pink. The traditional mix contains white, pink, red and salmon impatiens. The very popular mystic mix contains violet, bright eye, lilac and lavender blue.
- **Marigolds:** New this year! We have added the Boy o' Boy mix to our assortment. This wonderful mix of oranges and yellows will add a wonderful splash of color to your yard or plants.

HERBS

Enjoy fresh herbs from your garden this summer! We are offering: **basil, cilantro, parsley, dill, rosemary, thyme & chives.**
